

Requirements For The Use Of The IFCC Certification Logo(s)

The Certification IFCC Logo



This document describes the controls that IFC Certification Ltd has placed on the use of the IFCC Logo / UKAS Mark and must be read in conjunction with the relevant [General Requirements Scheme Document – Appendix A](#) which you hold certification for.

The IFCC Logo that a certificated company is able to use to distinguish itself in the marketplace through being certificated to one or more of IFCC’s schemes is included in the relevant scheme’s documents.

All IFCC logos are the property of IFC Certification Ltd. Their use must follow the guidance stipulated in this document. Any different usage not covered must first be approved by IFC Certification Ltd.

How to approve the use of a IFCC Logo

Certificated companies that wish to use the IFCC Logo outside of the rules defined in this document must first formally submit their request to IFC Certification Ltd to receive formal authorisation. The approval request must contain full details as listed below:

- ✓ Size
- ✓ Colour
- ✓ Location – where on the certificated product or what documentation
- ✓ Accompanying text
- ✓ Artwork Proof(s)

Where to use the IFCC Logo

Using the IFCC Logo in conjunction with the UKAS Mark should identify that your company is a member of a scheme which is accredited by UKAS and not that your company is a UKAS accredited company. The UKAS Mark cannot be displayed separated from the IFCC logo (see Figure D & E, section 7).

As an IFCC certificated company you are entitled to use the IFCC Logo with or without the UKAS Mark for marketing purposes.

The IFCC Logo (either with or without the UKAS Mark) may be used on stationery and other promotional material (brochures, websites, leaflets etc); as defined in the relevant General Requirements Scheme Document – Appendix A which you hold certification for.

Only the IFCC Company logo without the UKAS Mark maybe used on vehicles, buildings and flags. When using the IFCC Company logo without the UKAS Mark in these instances, it must always be used in conjunction with the Company’s Certification number placed centrally under the IFCC Logo (see Figure A2, B2 & C2, section 7).

Certificate holder’s responsibility

The certificate holder must:

- Ensure that use of the IFCC Logo complies with the General Requirements Scheme Document – Appendix A which you hold certification for.
- If the Certification ceases to be valid, howsoever caused, it is your responsibility to stop using and immediately remove the IFCC Logo from all company media.

IFCC Logo - Size and colour

The IFCC Logo can be proportionally enlarged or reduced providing that they are still legible.

IFCC Logo with or without the UKAS Mark must be reproduced using the colour references shown below. The use of alternatives colours on certificate holder’s documentation may be allowed but must be submitted to IFC Certification to obtain formal approval prior to use.
